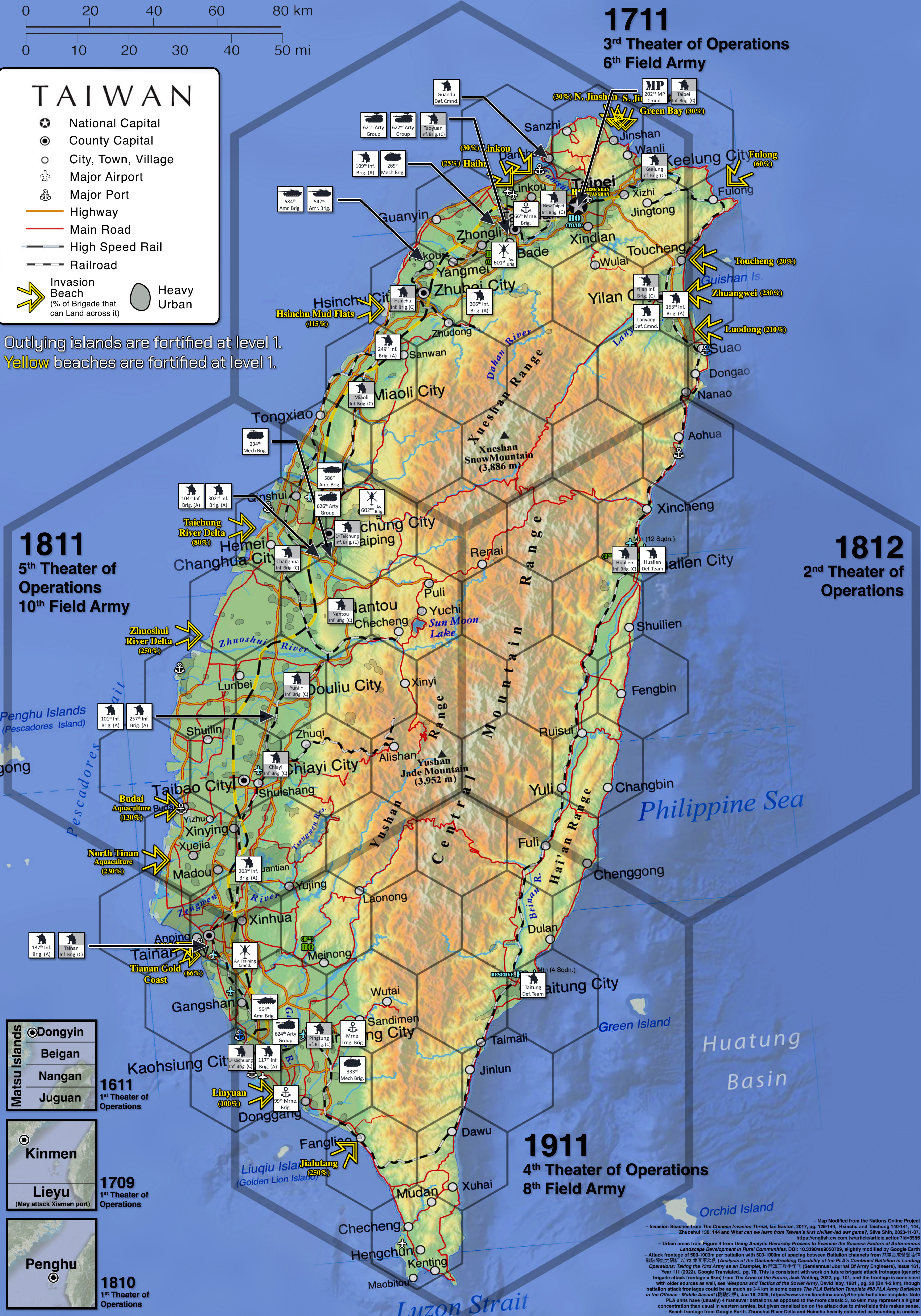

This is consistent with work on future brigade attack frontages (generic brigade attack frontage = 6km) from The Arms of the Future, Jack Watling, 2022, pg. 101, and the frontage is consistent with older sources as well, see Weapons and Tactics of the Soviet Army, David Isby, 1981, pg. 20 (Bn 1-2 km), though battalion attack frontages could be as much as 3-4 km in some cases The PLA Battalion Template #88 PLA Army Battalion in the Offense - Mobile Assault (機動突擊), Jan 16, 2025, https://www.vermillionchina.com/p/the-pla-battalion-templates. Note PLA units have (usually) 4 maneuver battalions as opposed to the more classic 3, so 6km may represent a higher concentration than usual in western armies, but given canalization on the attack due to minefields this makes sense.
